With a following of millions that includes some of the most powerful players in the tech, political, hedge fund and venture capital worlds, legendary tech journalist Sarah Lacy has gained a trusted reputation for investigative journalism that has made her one of the most listened-to influencers in Silicon Valley. By following where the money is going and digging into facts and numbers, Lacy spotlights emerging trends, separates truth from hype, spots the next game-changing entrepreneurs, and takes on what's keeping business leaders up at night often months before it's on other journalists' radar.

Lacy is currently Editor in Chief of Pando.com, the tech news site she founded in 2012. She raised \$4 million in venture capital (often bringing her newborn to pitch meetings) to launch the site after more than 15 years covering entrepreneurship and tech for *Business Week* and *TechCrunch*. With Pando's launch, she joined the less than 3 percent of VC--backed startups in Silicon Valley that are headed by women. Her upcoming book (working title: *A Uterus is a Feature, Not a Bug*) is a manifesto for strong mothers that contends that having children actually makes you stronger, not weaker, in the workplace.
