Walter De Brouwer is a Belgian-born Internet and technology entrepreneur and semiotician. He is a co-founder and the former-CEO of Scanadu in Mountain View, California. Located at the NASA Ames Research Park in California, Scanadu develops consumer health diagnostic devices such as the Scanadu Scout, designed to measure physiological parameters that include temperature, heart rate, blood oxygenation, respiratory rate, ECG, and diastolic/systolic blood pressure, and Scanaflo, an at-home, full-panel urinalysis testing device designed to give consumers immediate information about their liver health, urinary tract infections, and other vitals. Walter is also the founder and CEO of doc.ai. Among his many other accomplishments, he set up Riverland Publications in 1990 to publish personal computer magazines; published the cyberpunk cult magazine *Wave*; was one of the founders of PING; created the electronic employment site Jobscape; and set up OLPC Europe - the European branch of One Laptop per Child. His articles been published by such outlets as *The Huffington Post* and *Techonomy*; "How the People Are Taking Over the World" was among *Techonomy's* Most-Read Articles of 2014.

He earned a Master's degree in linguistics from the University of Ghent and a Ph.D. in semiotics from Tilburg University.
