Professor Richard Susskind OBE KC (Hon) is the President of the Society for Computers and Law, the founder of Remote Courts Worldwide and, since 1998, has been Technology Adviser to the Lord Chief Justice of England and Wales. He has written ten books, including *Tomorrow's Lawyers* (2013, 2017, 2023), *The Future of the Professions* (2015, 2022, with D Susskind), and *Online Courts and the Future of Justice* (2019, 2021). He is the world's most cited author on the future of legal services. His work has been translated into 18 languages and he has been invited to speak in over 60 countries. In the 1980s, Richard wrote his doctoral thesis on AI and the law at Balliol College, Oxford and went on to co-develop the world's first commercial AI system for lawyers.
